Life in small-town Bomont, USA, is peaceful until Ren McCormack - the city boy with the over-active sneakers - arrives and clashes with Reverend Shaw Moore, Bomont's authority figure. Challenging every one of Moore's opinions and breaking every taboo, Ren brings dance back to the heart of a town held back by the memory of a tragedy. He takes on the town. And wins.

The talented and energetic company has been hard at work since the fourth term last year preparing for what promises to be a theatrical experience to remember. **Nicholas Golding** and **Michael Weaver** share the leading role of Ren McCormack. The preacher's daughter, Ariel Moore - the highly sought-after lead role playing opposite Ren – is played by **Jade Hubner** and **Margeaux Malherbe** respectively. Also appearing are **Tim Dennis** and **Tammy De Klerk** as the Reverend Shaw Moore and his long-suffering wife Vi and **Sive Gubangxa** and **Dean De Klerk** as Rusty and Willard. They are joined on stage by a charismatic cast of 75.
