Message from our Head

Dear Parents

Assembly this week was led by our Counsellor, Miss Steenkamp. She spoke about relational aggression and explained that it is prominent amongst girls and it is important to help the girls to understand the concept of bullying to create a safe space for all girls in our school environment.

The following aspects were covered:

- What is bullying? The difference between being rude/ mean and bullying
- Is conflict normal?
- The difference between conflict and bullying
- The danger of keeping quiet and the importance of a support network at school and at home
- Factors related to physical, emotional, verbal and cyber bullying
- What does it mean to be a bystander?
- Herschel's protocol regarding bullying: consequences and counselling
- Steps you can take to stop bullying

Miss Steenkamp actively engaged the girls in various questions related to the sections covered in her presentation.


