Message from our Head

Dear Parents

Welcome back to 2021! It feels as though we have already had much communication as we face yet another year that is 'different'. No doubt we will continue to have to update policies and protocols as Covid-19 is guaranteed to have an impact on the way in which we function in our daily lives for the foreseeable future. It has been fabulous seeing the girls and having happy laughter, excited voices and smiling faces on campus. I have thoroughly enjoyed popping into each class and chatting to the girls.

Our theme for the first half of 2021 is '*Daring Greatly*'. I was reminded over the holiday period of the wise words of Brene Brown from her book *Daring Greatly*. She spends the first chapter telling her reader what she means when she speaks about Daring Greatly and in this she defines the ten goalposts for wholehearted living.

She uses data and research to unpack the concept of engaging with the world from a place of worthiness. So often in our schools our staff and students feel unworthy and 'not good enough' and this translates into a life that is not lived wholeheartedly.

Starting today and running into next week the focus will be Self-Compassion. This is often one of the most difficult spaces to navigate. As human beings we tend to become frustrated and beat ourselves up when we make mistakes or fail. I explained to the girls today that one of the key growing points in life is the ability to acknowledge our weaknesses and failures, be kind to ourselves and find ways in which to develop and grow in the area that we feel we are not strong. Please encourage discussion with your daughters with regard to this over the next two weeks. It is always helpful if parents are able to share their own experiences with their daughters. This is a good time to discuss realistic goals and expectations with your daughter, as often girls put unnecessary pressure on themselves believing that they know what their parents expectations of them are.

In Assembly today, Ms Juries spoke to us about how each and every person is amazing. In the story about Jesus calling his disciples who had been fisherman, Jesus recognized their special gifts; they were hardworking, they had carefully practiced skills and they were used to working under difficult circumstances. He saw their authenticity, how they were true to themselves and they did not try to change since becoming disciples. They also focused inwardly on God and it showed in their outward actions as they spread His love everywhere. Ms Juries reminded each and every girl that they are amazing just the way they are.

Sustainability




It is lovely to have all our external service providers back on campus this week and see the girls running off to their various activities and Herschel sport sessions.


