Dear Parents

In celebration of the 2020 Olympic Games this year, the Music Department is focusing on music and culture from around the world.

We introduced our theme at the Music Assembly on Tuesday with the help of the girls. The Grade 3s took the lead and highlighted The Netherlands as one of the European countries represented by the blue Olympic circle. They shared some interesting and fun facts about Dutch culture and sang a traditional Dutch children's song, accompanied by rhythm sticks, xylophones and piano. The Grade 5s demonstrated to us how to greet in different languages by performing 'Hello to the Children of the World' and the Grade 1 and 7s introduced the school to New Zealand with a Maori greeting song and some interesting facts on the National Anthem. It was wonderful to share a bit of what we have been learning about in class music with the rest of the school and we look forward to embracing many more cultures and stories from across the world this year.

On Wednesday we started the season of Lent with our Ash Wednesday Service in the School Hall. We heard about how Jesus spent 40 days and nights in the desert fasting, although he was tempted, he didn't give in and the angels came to look after him (Matthew 4: 1-11). Rev Lorna spoke about how God not only looks at the OUTside of us and what we do, but he also looks at the INside of us and what we think and feel.
